Bott Family Surgical Pavilion Heralds New Era of Surgical Medicine at Saint Clare's



Bruce and Gale Bott and family attended the opening ceremony and blessing on Monday, June 20, 2011, to celebrate the grand opening of Saint Clare's new *Bott Family Surgical Pavilion* located at the Denville campus.

Dedication and belief are often companions. For **Gale and Bruce Bott** of Flanders, their belief in the mission of Saint Clare's Health System has been matched by their dedication in service as trustees of Saint Clare's Foundation, and by their continued support of new ventures.

That support was evident as the \$14 million *Bott Family Surgical Pavilion* at Saint Clare's Hospital/Denville was opened, representing both a technological leap forward and a strategic plan designed to ensure Saint Clare's remains a health care leader into the future. The 20,985-square-foot pavilion, which began operations in June, features seven operating rooms that integrate industry-leading technologies and design features created to produce an effective, efficient surgical center.

"The new *Bott Family Surgical Pavilion* is the culmination of two years of extensive planning and construction to transform Saint Clare's surgical capabilities," said **Leslie D. Hirsch**, President and Chief Executive Officer at Saint Clare's Health

System. "This new facility will provide the latest in leading-edge surgical technology to the communities we serve." Hirsch said, "This is a new era of surgical medicine at Saint Clare's. The *Bott Family Surgical Pavilion* will attract patients and surgeons who will want to practice in this impressive facility." *(Continued on page 4)*

The opening of the *Bott Family Surgical Pavilion* places Saint Clare's in the company of some of the leading hospitals in the country. For example, real-time integrated video and communications systems from **Black Diamond Video** means Saint Clare's joins the Cleveland Clinic and Massachusetts General Hospital with the same technology.

The facility also includes some New Jersey firsts for Saint Clare's. The inclusion of advanced systems in LED surgical lights and operating room ceiling-mounted Equipment Management Systems from **TRUMPF** means Saint Clare's will be the first in the state and only the second in the country with this combination of advanced technologies. In addition, surgeons will also have access to the first hospital-owned simulation equipment in New Jersey for the latest in robotic surgery with the *da Vinci® Si Dual Console Surgical System*.

To support the Surgical Pavilion, Gale and Bruce Bott gave the hospital a \$1.5 million gift, the largest they've ever made to any organization, and one of largest individual gifts in Saint Clare's history. "Bruce and I are so indebted to Saint Clare's for their help through the years," said Gale Bott. "Life has been wonderful to us, and we thank God for that. This is our opportunity to give something back."

Gale and Bruce Bott have a rich history of philanthropy concerning Saint Clare's. They were chairs of the *Miracles* capital campaign several years ago, and made a significant gift that named the Newborn Nursery in the *Katena Center for Mother and Child* at Saint Clare's in memory of their grandniece. Both Gale and Bruce are current trustees of the Saint Clare's Foundation, with Bruce serving as Vice Chair.

Gale and Bruce Bott are long-time members of the community, now in their 36th year as residents of Flanders, N.J. Bruce is a structural engineer by training and Gale is a Registered Nurse who served as an operating room nurse at Saint Clare's/

Denville many years ago. Bruce Bott founded **Advanced Digital Data, Inc.**, which develops software for energy distribution companies such as fuel oil distributors and propane companies.

Governor Christie Signs Groundbreaking Law at Saint Clare's

New Jersey **Governor Chris Christie** visited Saint Clare's Denville campus on Friday, June 3, 2011, as Saint Clare's was chosen as the site where he signed into law groundbreaking legislation that will require testing to screen newborns for congenital heart defects.

The bill would require all birthing facilities to perform a pulse oximetry screening, which determines the amount of oxygen in the blood, before a newborn is discharged. The screenings must be completed a minimum of 24 hours after birth and on every newborn at a facility. The legislation makes New Jersey

the first state to mandate pulse oximetry testing on newborns statewide.

With President and CEO **Leslie D. Hirsch** by his side, the Governor thanked the senators who sponsored the bill. He believes Saint Clare's does "extraordinary work," and thanked all the staff for their hard work and compassion and called the work they do a "blessing." The signing of the law took place in the Urban Auditorium followed by a tour of Saint Clare's *Katena Center for Mother and Child*. The Auxiliary of Denville/Boonton Township has graciously funded new pulse oximetry testing for Saint Clare's.

Tenth Annual Cancer Walk Supports Creation of Learning Lounge

More than 1,500 people participated in the 10th Annual Walk for Breast Cancer Awareness held on September 18, 2011, at the Hilton Garden Inn at the Rockaway Townsquare Mall. The three-mile walk is a crusade to raise awareness of breast cancer and promote early diagnosis, and to raise funds to support cancer research. This year's event raised more than \$100,000 that will support the creation of the Cancer Care Learning Lounge at Cancer Care at Saint Clare's in Denville. The Learning Lounge will provide patients and their families with educational and other support materials as well as a tranquil location to meet with clinical staff. To date, the Walk has raised approximately \$900,000 for breast cancer treatment and new technology.

This year, **Carey Weick** was a featured survivor speaker, and told the crowd the story of her diagnosis, treatment, double mastectomy, and recovery. For many it was a familiar and heartwarming story. Weick was diagnosed with breast cancer last year just three weeks before thousands of supporters gathered outside the Hilton Garden Inn for the Ninth Annual Saint Clare's Walk for Breast Cancer Awareness. That day, Weick joined the "sisterhood" of cancer survivors and supporters, she said, when she was presented with a "survivor's shirt." Weick said, "They gave me the shirt that represented love and courage and hope. It was amazing walking with so many women who have had the same experience; it's a fascinating journey, I learned so much. I'm blessed to be a part of the sisterhood."

Weick said she was honored to speak to the walkers and supporters at this year's event. She said her battle with the disease has strengthened her family and helped her teen-aged children "grow up into compassionate young adults. Together, we battled Lupus for 12 years and now breast cancer," she said. "I feel I have an obligation to carry on, to honor the struggles of those who came before. It's difficult."

Walk Co-Chairs Reflect on Significance of Event

Donita Judge, Esq., Walk co-chair, knows all about the survivor's shirt, because she was the first recipient. "The first year I joined the Walk, I had just been diagnosed," she said. "I had no shirt, and a woman gave me her shirt, right off her back." When Judge returned to the event the following year to give the keynote speech as a cancer survivor, she spontaneously decided to pass the shirt on to a Saint Clare's patient undergoing cancer treatment.

That was the beginning of the "Sisterhood of the Traveling Survivors Shirt," Judge said. She has been a cancer survivor since 2007 and a member of the Walk committee for several years. The Walk introduced Judge to her doctors, nurses and therapists at Saint Clare's, who have been as important a network as her friends and family. The great benefit of the Walk is that it reminds the public that "we must act, not react" in order to combat the disease. "Early diagnosis and treatment are critical," Judge said.

Nancy McKinley, Walk co-chair, and representative of media sponsor **WMTR/WDHA**, said, "This is how we fight back." While breast cancer awareness has a national presence, McKinley said the Saint Clare's Walk provides a local charity that area women can identify with. The radio station's sponsorship is part of the mission of community

service, she said. Besides the active sponsorship of the Walk, radio personalities host shows that discuss the issue and the event. McKinley said the numbers relating to cancer are "really scary" even with improved education, diet, and treatment. She said as treatment has advanced with the help of funds raised by events like the Saint Clare's Walk, the outcomes have improved.

Cancer Patients Fighting Back with Fitness Program

While resistance training is one part of a fitness regimen led by Susan Siegmund, a registered nurse and health and fitness specialist at Saint Clare's, it could apply to the entire *Fighting Back with Fitness* program. Organizers said the eight-week program offered by Saint Clare's helps cancer survivors resist the physical, social and mental ill-effects of the disease. The program was started in 2010 with grants from **The Robert and Joan Dircks Foundation, Investor's Savings Bank and Pfizer, Inc.**, said Carol Diveny, Foundation and Corporate Relations Manager for Saint Clare's Foundation.

Patients can be referred to a member of the panel for consultation and treatment.

Fighting Back with Fitness is a program that combines standard exercises, a water fitness program and education about a range of topics. "It's about being well," said Brandy Johnson, who runs the water fitness program. Participants take part in physical training and counseling to deal with dietary issues, concerns about their body image, and the potential isolation that affects some dealing with cancer. The program also offers access to swimwear and other garments designed with cancer survivors in mind.

"You are a cancer survivor the moment you are diagnosed with cancer," Siegmund said. The fitness program is designed to bring back strength, improve flexibility and movement and cardiovascular health, she said.

Each participant has been cleared by their doctor to join the program. The water fitness program is held at the **West Morris YMCA** in Randolph, N.J. There are 45 participants in both the regular fitness and water fitness programs. Johnson's program is a specially designed set of water exercises.

The response from participants is an "evolving thing," she added. "At the beginning, many are not certain that they want to join, but at the end they are laughing and smiling."

Kathy Fisher, the Aquatic Director at the West Morris YMCA, said the program is designed to be "very, very social." Cancer is a "life-changing event," she said.

"*Fighting Back with Fitness* is a way to make that change for the better."

"The big day is when they graduate," Fisher said. "They are smiling. They are different women."

Framing the Future

The transformation of Saint Clare's continues to unfold with the completion of several capital projects. These projects are the result of two years of extensive planning that will help Saint Clare's meet the needs of the communities it serves in a changing healthcare environment with more than \$50 million in expansion, reconstruction and renovation projects to upgrade the facilities and technologies.

As a result, Saint Clare's Hospital/Denville now boasts the new state-of-the-art *Bott Family Surgical Pavilion* that was opened to the public in June. In the coming months, the Same Day Surgery unit in Denville will undergo renovations along with the first and second floors of the Urban Tower to improve the aesthetics and functionality of these important patient care areas.

Work on the Psychiatric Emergency Services (PES) area located in the Denville Emergency Department is complete and now has six patient rooms that offer increased privacy, a secure work station, and a physician area and utility space. This is the third phase of a five-phased project to update and modernize the Denville ED. Phase four of the ED project is ongoing and includes the construction of new office space.

The new *Women's Health Center* at Saint Clare's Hospital/Sussex just opened to patients this Fall. GetWellNetwork: A Patient-Centered Approach to Improved Satisfaction

When President and Chief Executive Officer **Les Hirsch** attended the Saint Clare's **Denville/Boonton Township Auxiliary** general membership meeting in 2009, he talked about a state-of-the-art **GetWellNetwork** that he thought would be good for Saint Clare's patients. Now more than two years later, the GetWellNetwork has arrived at Saint Clare's Denville campus. Thanks to the Denville/Boonton Township Auxiliary's generous pledge of \$500,000 to underwrite and pilot the project, Oncology patients, the Progressive Care Unit and all medical/surgical beds in Denville will now have this network that gives them access to education, entertainment and the ability to communicate with various hospital departments for requests.

"I come from a generation who did not grow up with computers," said Auxiliary Immediate Past President **Lou Noonan**. "When I heard Les Hirsch first talk about the GetWellNetwork, I thought that this would be a powerful tool for our patients."

The GetWellNetwork menu includes a health section, which features educational videos and information about a host of diseases, procedures and medications. It also enables patients to surf the Web, send and receive e-mails, and order on-demand movies. Another component of the GetWellNetwork is its customer service element. An "assistance" menu provides a list of possible issues a patient might have during their stay: my room is too hot; my room is too cold; my sink is leaking; my room hasn't been cleaned. The patient selects the appropriate option, and an instant message is sent to the person whose responsibility it is to handle the issue, such as maintenance or cleaning personnel – not the nurse on duty.

Debbie Regen, R.N., Executive Director, Nursing, was involved in the project and was key in pointing out the value of the GetWellNetwork from the Nursing perspective and how this new tool would increase patient satisfaction. "Nurses have really embraced these features," said Regen. "The GetWellNetwork means that they are no longer the middle man for many task-type requests, which frees them up for direct patient care."

Mary Ellen Furkey, current President of the Denville/Boonton Township Auxiliary, said, "Our auxiliary is committed to raising the necessary funds so that all patients at Saint Clare's Denville will have access to the GetWellNetwork."

The Saint Clare's Auxiliaries are an integral part of the Health System and have worked for many years to provide funding and support for important hospital projects.
